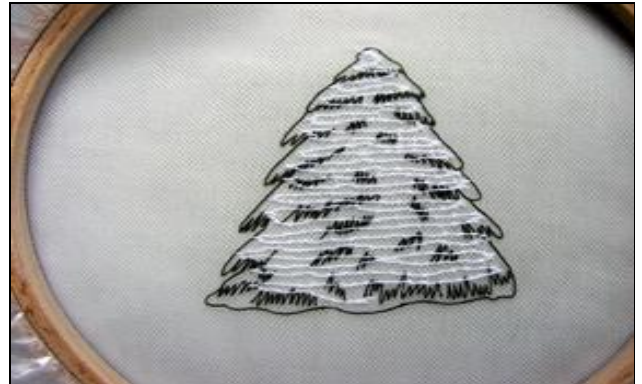


Thread Painting a Snowy Evergreen on the Tulle Sandwich with a Zigzag Stitch

The zigzag stitch creates more texture and dimension and is normally used in high stitch density designs.



Step 1 – Lay a piece of stabilizer, 2 pieces of tulle and a piece of water soluble stabilizer on which the design was drawn. Hoop the 4 layers



Step 2 – Thread paint underlay stitches moving hoop right to left while traveling up the tree (use a straight stitch to underlay the tree. Move hoop right to left with evergreen facing you.)



Step 3 – Using a 2.0 mm zigzag stitch and dark green thread, thread paint branches moving hoop right to left. Pick up needle and move to next section. Repeat.



Step 4 – Thread paint the snow using a 2.0 mm zigzag stitch. Rotate tree onto its side to execute the stitch. Fill in 1/3rd of the tree.



Step 5 – Thread paint the 2nd third of the evergreen tree. Rotate tree onto its side to execute the stitch. Fill in final 3rd of tree.



Step 6 – Completed evergreen. Congratulations, you are done!!!
